Position Title: Trail Construction Crew Volunteers

Position Description:

Trail Construction Crew members do heavy maintenance (tree removal, large trash removal, washout repair), or work on large construction projects (bridges, steps, boardwalks, stiles, side logging). A group of volunteers might spend one day helping with a single large construction project.. You are supervised and supported by a Trail Director and Construction Crew Leader.

Specialized Training:

Training is provided by the Trail Maintenance Director and Construction Crew Leader. Certification in chainsaw operation is helpful.

Time Commitment:

As needed, approximately one day per month.

Ideal For:

An individual, family, or group.

Towpath, Carolinian Crest, Black Walnut, Pinnacle
(Haldimand, Brant, Waterloo, Wellington Counties)

Transportation:

A vehicle is helpful, but carpooling can be arranged.
