

MAP 10 > Reroute of main trail at New Dundee Road + Blue Access Trail (May 2008)

Reference: MAP 10, Edition 6.0 (2006) - The main trail no longer follows New Dundee Road to Pinnacle Drive. At km 16.5 (Reichert Drive) the trail turns right onto the shoulder of New Dundee Road for about 125 m and turns left onto Robert Ferrie Drive. It proceeds to the traffic circle where it turns right onto Thomas Slee Drive and then left onto Monarch Wood Drive. The trail follows Monarch Wood Drive to its end and passes along a walkway to the right (east) of house # 55 (look for a black chain link fence). The trail passes through Topper Woods and exits on Forest Edge Trail (a residential street) opposite Windrush Park. It turns right along the sidewalk for a few metres and then turns left, crossing Autumn Ridge Trail (street) at a three-way stop. It follows the sidewalk of Windrush Trail (street) for about 120 m and turns right and up a slope into Pinnacle Hill Natural Area. The trail continues to Doon School. This reroute returns some on the main trail to two wooded areas where the trail used to be a few years ago prior to the urban development in the area. Note that construction in the area is ongoing.

At approximately km 18.5 [between houses 60 and 64, Autumn Ridge Trail (street)] the former main trail is a blue-blazed access trail. The trail passes between the two houses, over a stile and up a gradual slope to the main trail and is about 100 m in length.
