

MAP 10 > Reroute of main trail at approximately km 33.3 (May 2008)

Reference: MAP 10, Edition 6.0 (2006) – Turning right onto Zeller Drive (opposite a Walter Bean Grand River Trail parking lot and access point) the trail descends to the end of Zeller Drive where it turns left onto a crushed stone trail, which is part of the Walter Bean Grand River Trail. About 50 m along the crushed stone path, the GVT veers right along a footpath in a wooded area closer to the river. This footpath continues for about 1.5 km until it reaches a large rock. Note that this footpath is prone to flooding in the early spring so the use of the Walter Bean Grand River Trail on your left may be required.
