Trail Description for Reroute

Consult Map 13, 2006 of the Trail Description. Reroute text is bolded.

The trail continues past the Elora & District Community Centre & Arena, crosses the Irvine River on the David St Bridge, and turns right [11.0] onto a pathway (Lover's Leap footpath; see Points of Interest below) along the Irvine River into Victoria Park. The main trail follows the footpath through Victoria Park to the Church St right of way. It turns left on Church St **following it to Knox Presbyterian Church & turns right along Melville St, across Mill St E toward the river & turns left along a path, through Bissell Park, turns right & crosses the river on a pedestrian bridge to the Arthur St allowance. The trail then turns left along Water St for a short distance & then right on Bridge St. After 0.5 km the trail turns left & follows an abandoned rail trail & crosses the river. As you cross the river note the Wellington County Archives and Museum off in the distance (see Points of Interest/Historical Notes, Map 13). Shortly after crossing the river the trail descends a stairway and turns right into a woodlot and follows the river to & along Omar St/Bon Accord St where it enters the Lions Club arboretum & turns right toward km 16.3. Note that blazing through the woodlot and along Omar St/Bon Accord St may be missing. [The dashed red routes on the map are NOT side trails blazed & maintained by GVTA. Note that the dashed route shown behind the school is closed to hikers during activities at the request of the Upper Grand District School Board.]**

At km 16.3 it turns left to continue through woods ...
